- Veterans may be eligible for up to \$1,881/month
- Surviving spouse may be eligible for up to \$1,209/month
- Married veteran may be eligible for up to \$2,230/month

### DO YOU QUALIFY?

Under the right conditions, nearly a third of all seniors in the United States could qualify for up to \$2,230 per month in additional income from the Department of Veterans' Affairs.

Pensions are available to veterans who served on active duty during a period of war or to the single surviving spouses of these veterans. Of approximately 35 million Americans age 65 and older in this country, about 11.5 million are veterans who served during a period of war or their surviving spouses.
